(German)



He completed his state examination as a physiotherapist in 1999. Since then he has been working in a medical center specializing in heart and vascular diseases in northern Germany – the *Herz- und Gefäßzentrum Bad Bevensen* (<https://www.hgz-bb.de>). This center offers patients with heart and vascular diseases acute therapy and rehabilitation under one roof.

After working for ten years in all units of the center - including ICU cardiac and heart-thorax/vascular surgery in acute care and rehabilitation - Alexander became the director of physical therapy. In 2008 he completed a further training as a specialist in social and health care. He also works as an Instructor for outpatient heart group trainer. Alexander has published several articles on leg amputations und arteric-vessel-trainings in specialist magazines. He was also a co-author in a technical book for physical therapy used in internal medicine. Furthermore he worked as a lecturer and mentor for physiotherapy students and he collaborated in the development of a digital rehabilitation app.

On 30/04/2024 the ICCrPT held its second webinar for International colleagues under the topic, 'Outcome Measures in Acute Care: What are we using, how and why?'



It was delivered by Harriet Shannon from UCL, London UK and Simone Gruenig from the University of British Columbia and Capilano University, Canada.

Harriet opened the session by offering an overview of the aspects of outcome measurement that are important for accurate measurements, including their reliability, validity, clinical meaningfulness and responsiveness. She also introduced the idea of core outcome sets as a way of ensuring consistency between both research and clinical groups, enabling better collaborations nationally and internationally.

Simone then offered practical guidance on chest x-ray and blood gas interpretation. She introduced the audience to a systematic approach to x-ray interpretation, making careful comparisons between right and left sides and understanding what looks 'normal' versus unusual. For blood gases, Simone had an invaluable flow diagram that acknowledged the complexities of blood gas analysis (available on the ICCrPT website on the slidedeck for the event).

During questions towards the end of the webinar, the differences between adults and children were discussed. Newer outcome measures including lung ultrasound and electrical impedance tomography were also considered. Our webinars are free to attend, and open to all with an interest in cardiorespiratory physiotherapy –
